A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND SUPPORTING INITIATIVE MEASURE NO. 735, CONCERNING A PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE FEDERAL CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the spending of money by individuals in elections has
been construed by the U.S. Supreme Court to be protected free speech
under the First Amendment of the Constitution of the United States and
those protections have been extended to corporations and other legal
entities as well; and

7 WHEREAS, previous U.S. Supreme Court decisions have eroded
 8 the authority of government to regulate campaign contributions and
 9 expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the prompt disclosure of all political contributions and
 expenditures in a manner accessible to voters prior to elections is in the
 best interest of holding free and fair elections; and

15 WHEREAS, Initiative 735 seeks to make Washington the 18th 16 state calling for a U.S. constitutional amendment to overturn such 17 decisions; and

WHEREAS, as allowed by RCW 42.17A.555, the City Council ofKirkland desires to show its support to Initiative 735.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the Cityof Kirkland as follows:

25 <u>Section 1</u>. The City Council supports Initiative 735, concerning
 26 a proposed amendment to the Federal Constitution.

28 <u>Section 2</u>. The City Council urges Kirkland voters to vote yes on
 29 Initiative 735.
