ORDINANCE
No. 503

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOITERING IN AND ABOUT THE STREETS AFTER CERTAIN HOURS, COMMONLY KNOWN AS A "CURFEW" ORDINANCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any child or minor under the age of Eighteen (18) years to loiter in or about any public pool or billiard room or hall or cardroom or to be abroad in or upon any public street or public place in the City of Kirkland after the hour of 11:00 o'clock P. M. and before the hour of 7:00 o'clock A. M., except when accompanied by his or her parents or guardian or when engaged in lawful employment.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any parent or guardian of any child or minor under the age of Eighteen (18) years to allow or permit such child or minor to loiter in or about any public poolroom or hall or billiard room or to be abroad in or upon any public street or public places within the City of Kirkland between the hours of 11:00 o'clock P. M. and 7:00 o'clock A. M., except when accompanied by his or her parents or guardian or when engaged in lawful employment.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any persons to loiter upon or about the ferry dock or in or upon any public street or public place between the hours of 9:30 o'clock P. M. and 5:30 o'clock A. M.

Section 4. Any persons violating any provision of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) or imprisonment in jail for a term not to exceed ten (10) days.

Section 5. Ordinance No. 177 of the City of Kirkland is hereby repealed.
