

ORDINANCENo. 504

AN ORDINANCE MAKING IT A MISDEMEANOR TO PUT GRASS CUTTINGS, DEBRIS, AND OTHER SUBSTANCE AND MATERIALS IN THE CITY DRAINAGE DITCHES OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any persons in the City of Kirkland to put or allow to be placed in any of the drainage ditches in and for the City of Kirkland any grass cuttings, paper, debris, or foreign substance of any kind or character whatsoever, so as to in any way impede the flow of water in said drainage ditches.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not to exceed Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) or imprisonment in jail for a term not exceeding ten days, or both in the discretion of the court.
