

ORDINANCE

No. 513

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 464, BY CHANGING CERTAIN USE DISTRICT BOUNDARY LINES, BY CREATING NEW COMMERCIAL USE DISTRICTS ALONG CENTRAL AVENUE AND ALONG MARKET STREET.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Zoning Map in and for the City of Kirkland as identified in Section 1, Paragraph 2, of Zoning Ordinance No. 464, is hereby amended by changing and re-zoning from an R-1 District to a B-1 District the following-described property, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, to-wit:

Lots one (1) to Fourteen (14), inclusive, Block Eight (8);  
Lots One (1) to Six (6), inclusive, Block Sixteen (16);  
Lots Eleven (11) to Fourteen (14), inclusive, Block One Hundred Seventy Seven (177); Lots Nine (9) to Sixteen (16), inclusive, Block One Hundred ~~Eighteen~~ <sup>seventy</sup> (178); Lots Nine (9) to Sixteen (16), inclusive, Block One Hundred Ninety Three (193), and Lots Fifteen (15) and Sixteen (16), Block One Hundred Ninety Four (194); Town of Kirkland;

Blocks Ninety-five (95), Ninety-six (96), and Ninety-seven (97), Kirkland Terrace, and Blocks One Hundred Eighty Six (186) and Two Hundred one (201), Supplementary Plat of Town of Kirkland.
