

ORDINANCE

No. 516-B *Am 10/27/49*

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 500.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 7 and Section 12 of Ordinance No. 500, which read as follows, to-wit,

"Section 7. The City hereby gives and grants to Paul Razzore, doing business as the North End Disposal Company, herein referred to as the garbage collector, the right for a period of one year from the date this ordinance shall take effect, of collecting, gathering and hauling over the streets of the City of Kirkland, all garbage, ashes or rubbish accumulating therein, upon the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth."

"Section 12. The Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of said City an agreement with Paul Razzore, doing business as the North End Disposal Company, substantially in the form set forth in Exhibit A hereto attached and made a part hereof."

be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 2. Section 7 of said Ordinance No. 500 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The City shall from time to time enter into contracts with persons designated as "garbage collectors", giving such persons the right, for stipulated periods of time, to collect, gather and haul over the streets of the City of Kirkland all garbage, ashes or rubbish accumulated in said City, subject to all the terms and conditions of Ordinance No. 500.

Section 3. Section 12 of said Ordinance No. 500 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Mayor and City Clerk of the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized to make and execute on behalf of the City of Kirkland, from time to time, upon specific direction and motion of the Council, an agreement or contract with persons designated as the garbage collectors for the City of Kirkland.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon
its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
