

ORDINANCE

No. 519

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROHIBITING THE OPERATION OF TAVERNS AND PIN-BALL MACHINES NEAR PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

1. That the operation of taverns and pin-ball machines within a distance of three hundred feet (300') from any established public school within the City Limits of Kirkland be and the same hereby is prohibited.

2. Any one found guilty of violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days or both, said fine and imprisonment.
