

ORDINANCE NO. 523

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF AN ALLEY WAY  
IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

The CITY COUNCIL of the CITY OF KIRKLAND do ordain as follows:

That the petition to vacate the portion of that certain alley situate immediately East of the Eastside Motor Company Garage in the City of Kirkland, which said portion proposed to be vacated is as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Unplatted Tract "A" in Burke and Farrar's Business Center Addition, Division No. 25, as recorded in volume 25 of plats, page 14, records of King County, Washington; thence North 89-39'-00" East, 98.54 feet to the true point of beginning; thence North 2-21'-00" East, 30.03 feet; thence South 0-21'-00" East, 30.00 feet; thence South 89-39'-00" West, 1.46 feet, to the true point of beginning.

Be and the same hereby is granted.

This ordinance is passed in pursuance of the original petition filed with the Clerk of the City of Kirkland, and signed by the owners of more than two-thirds (2/3) of the private property abutting upon the said alley which portion of said alley is to be vacated as fully described in said petition.

Due and proper notice of the pendency of the said petition to vacate the above-mentioned portion of said alley in the City of Kirkland was formally given as required by law the 18th day of November, 1946, notifying that the 16th day of December, 1946, was the date set for the hearing of the above-mentioned petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the plat filed with the City Clerk of Kirkland relating to the vacating of said street properties is hereby approved.

Passed by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, this 16th day of December, 1946, and introduced this 18th day of November, 1946.
