AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NO. 464, BY RESTRICTING SERVICE STATIONS WITHIN A CERTAIN DESCRIBED PORTION OF THE COMMERCIAL USE DISTRICT.

Bounded on the West by Lake Avenue North, Bounded on the South by Kirkland Avenue, Bounded on the East by Second Street and bounded on the North by a line adjacent to and parallel with and 100 feet north from the North boundary of Central Avenue.
