AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S RELIEF FUND FOR THE FIREMEN SERVING WITH THE VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF REMINGTON'S REVISED STATUTES, SECTION 9578-15 et. seq. (1945).

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City of Kirkland does hereby subscribe to those certain provisions contained in Remington's Revised Statutes, 1945 Supplement, Section 9578-15 et. seq., for the creation of a death and disability insurance protection for the members of the Volunteer Fire Department of the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. The City Treasurer in and for the City of Kirkland is hereby directed to pay annually, on or before the first day of March, of each year, to the State Treasurer in and for the State of Washington, a sum equal to a total amount of Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each member of the Kirkland Volunteer Fire Department, for the payment of the annual premium for the insurance hereby created.

Section 3. There is hereby created a Board of Trustees of the Kirkland Fire Department for the purpose of administering the provisions of this Ordinance, which said Board of Trustees shall consist of the Mayor, the City Clerk, and one Councilman to be appointed by the Mayor, the Chief of the Fire Department, and one member of the Fire Department to be elected by the members of said Fire Department for a term of one year and annually thereafter. The Mayor is hereby designated as Chairman of said Board of Trustees, and the Clerk is hereby designated as Secretary of said Board, and the Treasurer thereof. It shall be the duties of said Board of Trustees to carry out the provisions of said State Volunteer Relief Fund Act.
