

ORDINANCE NO. 541

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR THE YEAR 1948.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

THAT the budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1948 be and the same hereby is adopted, and appropriation totals shall be allowed for each of the following classes, as follows:

1. Salaries and wages -----	\$ 114,220.00
2. Maintenance and operation -----	86,645.00
3. Capital outlay -----	105,630.00
4. Interest and Debt Redemption -----	21,750.00

Estimated Revenue ---	\$ 328,245.00

And be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1948 is hereby fixed at .015.
