ORDNANCE NO. 554

AN ORDNANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SHOWING OF CARNIVAL ATTRACTIONS IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, SETTING THE LICENSE FEE THEREFOR AND AMENDING ORDNANCE NO. 502.-a

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 502 which provides as follows; to wit, "That there is hereby established a license fee for each carnival hereafter doing business in the City of Kirkland of \$10.00 for each day said carnival is doing business in said City and in addition thereto, the sum of \$5.00 for each carnival concession for each day said concession is held open to the public" be and the same hereby is amended by adding at the end thereof the following provision; to wit; PROVIDED HOWEVER, that whenever any such carnival is sponsored by a local charitable or non-profit association, corporation or organization, the city council may in its discretion upon application therefor provide for such carnival a flat license fee of \$100.00 in lieu of the fees in this section above provided, for six successive days.
