ORDINANCE NO. 556

ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT POLICE JUDGE IN AND FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That there be and there hereby is created the position of Assistant Police Judge in and for the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. Appointment to the position of Assistant Police Judge shall be at the will of the Mayor.

Section 3. No salary or emolument shall be paid to the Assistant Police Judge for his other duties in that position.

Section 4. An appointee to the position of Assistant Police Judge shall hold office at the will of the Mayor.

Section 5. The duties of the Assistant Police Judge shall be to act as Judge of the Kirkland Police Court when the regularly appointed Police Judge is absent, unavailable, or otherwise unable to perform the duties of that office.
