

ORDINANCE NO. 560

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROVIDING THAT RECEIPTS FROM THE OPERATION OF PARKING METERS SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN THE GENERAL FUND IN THE CITY TREASURY, ABOLISHING THE PARKING METER FUND AND REPEALING SECTION 15 OF ORDINANCE NO. 496.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That receipts derived from the operation of Parking Meters in the City of Kirkland shall be deposited in the General Fund of the City Treasury, and all expenses incurred under the provisions of Ordinance No. 496 in the operation of these Parking Meters shall be paid by City Warrant as a current expense of the General Government from the General Fund.

Section 2. That the Parking Meter Fund of the City Treasury be and the same hereby is abolished and Section 15 of Ordinance No. 496 be and the same hereby is repealed.
