

ORDINANCE NO. 570

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR THE YEAR 1949 BY PROVIDING THEREIN FOR THE OPERATION OF THE KIRKLAND - SEATTLE FERRY, FOR THE PERIOD ~~FEBRUARY 1, 1948~~ <sup>December</sup> TO ~~FEBRUARY 1, 1950~~ <sup>December 1, 1949</sup>.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1949 be and the same hereby is supplemented and added to by providing for the operation of the Kirkland-Seattle Ferry for the period ~~February 1, 1948~~ <sup>December</sup> to ~~February 1, 1950~~ <sup>December 1, 1949</sup> as follows:
