ORDINANCE NO. 571

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM, ESTABLISHING MINIMUM RATES FOR INDIVIDUAL USERS OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE BOUNDARY LINES OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AND REDUCING THE MINIMUM CHARGE FOR SUCH USERS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

For water service outside of the corporate boundary lines of the City of Kirkland, the following rate will prevail: For the first one thousand (1,000) cubic feet or less - \$2.25.

Section 2.

All other rules and regulations, rates, charges, and costs, shall be and remain as heretofore fixed or established by Ordinance, Resolution or Statute.

Section 3.

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
