ORDINANCE NO. 579

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, 1949 EDITION, OF THE PACIFIC COAST BUILDING OFFICIALS CONFERENCE, OF LOS ANGELES, CALIFORNIA, AS THE BUILDING CODE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND; AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ERECTION, CONSTRUCTION, ENLARGEMENT, ALTERATION, REPAIR, MOVING, REMOVAL, CONVERSION, DEMOLITION, OCCUPANCY, EQUIPMENT, USE, HEIGHT, AREA, AND MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS OR STRUCTURES IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND; PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS AND COLLECTION OF FEES THEREFOR; DECLARING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE DISTRICTS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That the Building Code of the City of Kirkland shall be the Uniform Building Code, 1949 Edition, adopted by the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference at the 6th Annual Meeting, October, 1927, with Revisions and Additions approved at the 26th Annual Meeting, October, 1948, Published January 1, 1949, Printing of January 1, 1949, Copyright, 1949, by Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, 124 West Fourth Street, Los Angeles, California. That this Code is hereby adopted as fully and to all purposes as if set forth in full herein, and is by this

reference incorporated herein as an Ordinance of the City of Kirkland, and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
