

ORDINANCE NO. 580

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION TO INDUSTRIAL CLASSIFICATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential classification to industrial classification:

Beginning at the NW corner of Tract "B", South Kirkland Acreage, according to plat thereof recorded in Vol. 11 of Plats, Page 94, records of King County, Washington; thence S 17°23' W 541.75 feet along the easterly marginal line of the Northern Pacific Railway right of way; to county road; thence S 88°49' E 332.02 feet along said county road; thence N 519.81 feet to the north line of said Tract "B"; thence N 88°38' W 170.42 along the N line of said Tract "B" to the point of beginning.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
