ORDINANCE NO. 590

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING A REQUIREMENT THAT ALL CITY EMPLOYEES MUST RESIDE WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND PROVIDING THAT THERE SHALL BE A GRACE PERIOD OF ONE YEAR FROM JUNE 1, 1950 WITHIN WHICH TIME PRESENT EMPLOYEES MAY MOVE WITHIN THE SAID CITY LIMITS AND MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS ORDINANCE.

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and proper that all employees of the City of Kirkland should reside within the City Limits of said City, now therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All employees of the City of Kirkland must maintain residence and actually live within the City Limits of the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. Present City of Kirkland employees living outside the City Limits may have a grace period of one year from June 1, 1950 within which time to change their residence and meet the requirements of this Ordinance, otherwise their employment shall be terminated at the end of said period of grace.

Section 3. That all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and they hereby are repealed.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after five days after the date of its publication.

Introduced the 5th day of June, 1950.
