

ORDINANCE NO. 594

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION TO COMMERCIAL CLASSIFICATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential classification to commercial classification:

The South 305.4 feet of Tax Lot One, Burke & Farrar Division #25, being that part of said tax lot not already rezoned for Commercial use by Kirkland City Ordinance #577 of August 1st, 1949, King County, Washington.

Tracts 1, 2, and 3, South Kirkland Acreage, King County, Washington.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
