

ORDINANCE NO. 595

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION TO PERMIT THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CHURCH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential classification to permit the construction of a Church:

That portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, Township 25 North, Range 5 East W.M. described as follows: Beginning at the meander post between sections 5 and 8 in said Township and Range; thence S 16^o15'00" east 12.00 chains; thence S 5.49 chains; thence East 41.25 feet; thence S 627 feet; thence east 550 feet to the true point of beginning; thence east 260 feet; thence N 313.50 feet; thence west 260 feet; thence S 313.50 feet to the true point of beginning, King County, Washington.

Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the mayor, and its publication according to law.
