

ORDINANCE NO. 599

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REPEALING SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 593 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND ENACTING A NEW SECTION 4 OF SAID ORDINANCE PROVIDING THAT ANY PERSON FOUND GUILTY OF VIOLATING SAID ORDINANCE SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT TO EXCEED \$300.00 OR IMPRISONED IN THE CITY JAIL NOT TO EXCEED NINETY DAYS, OR BOTH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 593 which reads as follows:

"Section 4.

Any person found guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$100.00, or imprisoned in the city jail not to exceed thirty days, or both."

be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2.

That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 593 shall be and read as follows:

"Section 4.

Any person found guilty of a violation of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed \$300.00, or imprisoned in the city jail not to exceed ninety days, or both."

Section 3.

That all other parts, portions or paragraphs of Ordinance No. 593 shall be and remain as heretofore fixed and established by Ordinance, Resolution or Statute.

Section 4.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
