C. H. J. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND SETTING SALARY SCHEDULES FOR THE POLICE, STREET, WATER, SEWER, AND PARK DEPARTMENTS, RAISING SOME SALARIES AND AMENDING ANY ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT THEREWITH TO TAKE EFFECT AS OF FEBRUARY 1, 1951.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The salaries of members of the Police Department of the City of Kirkland shall be as follows:

- (1) The first three months following appointment, \$250 per month.
- (2) From the fourth to twenty-fourth months, \$275 per month.
- (3) After two years the salary shall be \$290 per month.
- (4) The Chief of Police shall be paid \$300 per month.

Section 2. The salaries of employees of the Park, Street, Sewer and Water Departments shall be.

- (1) \$250 per month for the first three months after employment.
- (2) \$275 per month after the first three months.
- (3) The Superintendents of these Departments shall receive \$300 per month.

Section 3. The salaries provided for herein shall not apply to part time or special employees. The hourly wage in all Departments shall be \$1.35.

Section 4. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to make this Ordinance effective.

Section 5. The salaries herein provided shall take effect as of February 1, 1951.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.
