ORDINANCE NO. 609

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A LICENSE REQUIREMENT FOR ALL SLOT MACHINES AND SETTING THE FEE FOR SUCH LICENSE AT THE RATE OF \$25.00 PER MONTH FOR EACH MACHINE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there shall be a license requirement for all slot machines in the City of Kirkland. This shall apply to the coin operated devices known as slot machines and not to pin ball or other devices regulated by other Ordinances.

Section 2. That the fee for such license shall be at the rate of \$25.00 per month for each machine.

Section 3. That all fees due and payable on account of license fees provided herein shall be payable monthly in advance. The charges and fees herein provided for shall become effective on and after August 1, 1951.

Section 4. That all sections or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby are repealed, to the extent necessary to make the provisions hereof effective.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
