

ORDINANCE

NO. 617

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR THE YEAR 1952.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1952 be and the same hereby is adopted and the appropriation totals shall be allowed for each of the following classes, as follows:

1. Salaries and Wages -----	= \$ 126,740.00
2. Maintenance and Operation -----	106,533.00
3. Interest and Debt Redemption-----	62,910.00
4. Capital Outlay-----	<u>38,350.00</u>
Estimated Revenue-----	\$ 334,533.00

And be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1952 is hereby fixed at .015.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after five (5) days after the date of its publication.
