ORDINANCE NO. 620

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING THE SALARY FOR THE OFFICE OF MAYOR IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 536.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 536 which reads as follows:

"That there is hereby established for the office of Mayor in and for the City of Kirkland, a salary in the sum of Three Thousand Nine Hundred Dollars (\$3900.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly payments of Three Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$325.00) each period" be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

That commencing July 1, 1952 the salary for the office of Mayor in and for the City of Kirkland shall be in the sum of \$6000.00 per annum payable in equal monthly payments of \$500.00 each.

Section 2. The salary provided for in this Ordinance shall become effective on or after July 1, 1952.

Section 3. That all Ordinances or sections of Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby are repealed to the extent necessary to make the provisions hereof effective. That Ordinance No. 536 of the City of Kirkland shall be and remain in effect through June, 1952.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.
