

ORDINANCE NO. 623

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION TO PERMIT THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CHURCH:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1

That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential classification to permit the construction of a Church:

Lots 1 to 15 inclusive, Block 2, Seattle Addition to Kirkland, King County, Washington.

Section 2

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor and its publication according to law.
