

ORDINANCE NO. 628

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING A PORTION OF SECTION 4, AND ALL OF SECTION 10, OF ORDINANCE NO. 569 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, RELATING TO CHARGES FOR WATER SERVICE BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That that portion of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 569, of the City of Kirkland, which reads as follows:

"All water services charged on the bases of a flat rate service, are due and payable in advance on the first day of each calendar month. If paid not later than the tenth day of said calendar month the charge shall be at the rate set forth in this ordinance. If said service charge is made later than the fifteenth day of said calendar month, an additional twenty-five cents (25¢) will be required for delinquent payment."

be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 569 of the City of Kirkland which reads as follows:

"Section 10. Water Service to City of Kirkland. Government:

This schedule applies to the use of water by the Governmental Departments of the City of Kirkland and shall consist of a flat rate charge for the following services:

- a. City Hall \$10.00 per month
- b. City Shed 100.00 per year
- c. Restrooms 100.00 per year
- d. Parks 180.00 per year
- e. Sewer Plant 2.00 per month
- f. Municipal Hydrants 1200.00 per year
- g. Ferry Concession 100.00 per year "

be and the same hereby is repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force 5 days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
