

ORDINANCE NO. 633

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THAT THERE EXISTS A PUBLIC EMERGENCY OF THE CHARACTER ENUMERATED IN THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON, SECTION 35.33.080, WHICH SAID EMERGENCY COULD NOT REASONABLY HAVE BEEN FORESEEN AT THE TIME OF MAKING THE BUDGET FOR 1952, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1000.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE IMMEDIATE EXPENDITURE OF SAID SUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF OPERATING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, an emergency exists which affects the health and welfare of the population of the City of Kirkland in that the Police Department within the City cannot be properly maintained without an immediate appropriation for operating funds, and it is necessary that such work be carried on to adequately serve the needs of the citizens of Kirkland and preserve order, and additional funds in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) are necessary to pay the expenses thereof for the balance of the fiscal year of 1952;

AND WHEREAS, the necessity of said expenditures could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the preparation of the budget for the fiscal year of 1952, and the appropriation therefor by the City Council, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DOES HEREBY FIND that an emergency exists for the appropriation of the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000.00) to be used for said uses and purposes, and there is hereby appropriated for the General Government of the City of Kirkland for the specified use for operating expenses of the Police Department, the sum of One Thousand Dollars. It is further ordained that the sum of One Thousand Dollars be transferred from the Replacement Fund of the Water Department as a loan from said Replacement Fund to be repaid to that Fund without interest during the fiscal year of 1953.

This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of order of the Public health and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Kirkland, and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect immediately.

Introduced and emergency declared and this Ordinance passed and approved this 6th day of October, 1952.
