ORDINANCE NO. 640

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR, PROHIBITING MINORS FROM ACQUIRING, POSSESSING OR CONSUMING THE SAME AND PROHIBITING OTHERS FROM SUPPLYING TO OR PERMITTING THE CONSUMPTION OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR BY MINORS AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES.

WHEREAS, it is in the interests of public safety, health and morals that the acquisition, possession and consumption of intoxicating liquor by minors should be regulated and controlled and that the supplying of liquor to and the permitting of consumption of liquor by minors should be controlled, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to acquire in any manner, consume, or have in his possession any intoxicating liquor as defined by Section 3 of Chapter 62 of the Laws of 1933. Extraordinary Session, as amended by Chapter 158 of the Laws of 1935 of the State of Washington: PROVIDED, that the foregoing shall not apply in the case of liquor given or permitted to be given to such person under the age of twenty-one (21) years by his parent or guardian for medicinal purposes, or administered to him by his physician or dentist for medicinal purposes.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to give, or otherwise supply intoxicating liquor to any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years or permit any person under that age to consume intoxicating liquor on his premises or on any premise under his control, except as provided in Section 1 of this ~~resolution~~ ordinance.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ~~resolution~~ ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor as defined under the laws of the State of Washington, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
