ORDINANCE NO. 641

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND VACATING A 16 foot alley Block 99, of Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Business Center as shown in the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, page 14, bounded on the West by the northerly extension of the West line of lot &, said Block 99 and on its easterly termination by the north line of Cecile Avenue, presently known as First Avenue South, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington.

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 418 of the City of Kirkland the Council of the said City of Kirkland set the date of May 4, 1953, for a hearing on the proposed vacation of a 16 foot alley in Block 99, of Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Business Center as shown in the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, page 14, bounded on the West by the northerly extension of the West line of lot 28, said Block 99 andon its easterly termination by the north line of Cecile Avenue, presently known as First Avenue South, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington.

AND WHEREAS, it appears desirable for the best interest of the City and the property owners concerned that said alley be vacated.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described portion of an alley be and the same hereby is vacated:

A 16 foot alley in Block 99, of Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Business Center as shown in the plat thereof as recorded in Volume 25 of Plats, page 14, bounded on the West by the northerly extension of the West line of Lot 28, said Block 99 and on its easterly termination by the North line of Cecile Avenue, presently known as First Avenue South, situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State of Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor, and its publication according to law.
