ORDINANCE NO. 646

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON PROVIDING AN AMENDMENT TO EXISTING BUILDING CODE REQUIRING ALL RESIDENCE DWELLINGS TO HAVE A MINIMUM LIVABLE AREA OF NOT LESS THAN 650 SQUARE FEET EXCLUSIVE OF ATTACHED GARAGES, PORCHES AND PATIOS, WHETHER COVERED OR OPENED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That in addition to existing requirements and regulations of the Building Code and other Ordinances. of residence dwellings hereafter constructed or built within the City of Kirkland, shall have a minimum livable area of not less than 650 square feet exclusive of attached garages, porches and patios whether covered or opened.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
