

ORDINANCE NO. 649

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION TO INDUSTRIAL CLASSIFICATION.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential classification to industrial classification:

Beginning at a point on the north line of Tract "B", South Kirkland Acreage which is 167.94 feet west of the northeast corner of said Tract; thence South 519.04 feet more or less to the north margin of the county road (Northeast 68th Street); thence north $88^{\circ}49'$ west 240.38 feet along the said north margin of the county road; thence north 519.27 feet to the north line of said Tract "B"; thence easterly along the said north line to the point of beginning, King County, State of Washington.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and its publication according to law.
