ORDINANCE NO. 653

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REPEALING A PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 438 OF SAID CITY AND RE-ENACTING THE SAME TO ALLOW THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN THE SUM OF .08¢ PER MILE TRAVELED, FOR USE OF THEIR AUTOMOBILES FOR CITY BUSINESS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of Ordinance No. 438 of the City of Kirkland which reads as follows:

"a. In the event the Mayor or councilmen are required to use their automobile within or without the municipal limits for City business, they shall be allowed their transportation at the following rate: 5¢ per mile traveled, together with all additional and actual expenses incurred while on municipal business."

be and the same hereby is repealed and re-enacted to read as follows:

a. In the event the Mayor or councilmen <sup>or other elected officials</sup> are required to use their automobile within or without the municipal limits for City business, they shall be allowed their transportation at the following rate:

.08¢ per mile traveled, together with all additional and actual expenses incurred while on municipal business.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, its approval by the Mayor and its publication according to law.
