

ORDINANCE NO. 657

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR THE YEAR 1954.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1954 be and the same hereby is adopted and the appropriation totals shall be allowed for each of the following classes, as follows:

1. Salaries and Wages - - - - -	155,970.00
2. Maintenance and Operation - - - - -	201,897.00
3. Capital Outlay - - - - -	12,850.00
4. Interest and Debt Redemption - - - - -	<u>75,045.00</u>
Estimated Revenue - - - - -	\$445,762.00

And be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1954 is hereby fixed at .015.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
