ORDINANCE 0-4562

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PAYMENT OF COSTS OF PROSECUTION UPON CONVICTION OF A CRIME.

WHEREAS, as part of a legal review of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") by Code Publishing Company it was noted that the federal Department of Justice ("DOJ") has warned against practices that raise revenues without supporting justice; and

WHEREAS, one practice of concern to DOJ has been the imprisonment of individuals convicted of crimes simply on the basis of their having failed to pay fines and costs levied by a court; and

WHEREAS, KMC Section 1.04.030 provides for the imprisonment of individuals who have failed to pay the costs of their prosecution; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Court Judge, Chief of Police and Prosecuting Attorney for the City of Kirkland all support the repeal of KMC Section 1.04.030.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 1.04.030 is repealed.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
