

ORDINANCE NO. 660

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS TO COMMERCIAL SPRAYERS AND REQUIRING THAT PERMITS BE GRANTED ONLY TO STATE LICENSED INDIVIDUALS OR FIRMS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That hereafter a permit be required from any and all persons, firms, corporations or others doing commercial spraying for the control of pests or insects of any kind before such work is done for residents, businesses or property owners in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. That permits to persons or firms doing spraying for the control of pests or insects of any kinds be issued only to persons or firms having a State License who have complied with all requirements of the State of Washington, concerning bonds, insurance and all requirements as to method and type of operation together with equipment or materials used.

Section 3. The fee for issuance of the permit shall be collected by the City Clerk in the amount of \$5.00, annually, permits expiring December 31.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
