

ORDINANCE NO. 663

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 483 AND THEREBY REMOVING ADMISSIONS TAXES IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 483, which is an ordinance levying an admission tax on persons paying admissions, or who are admitted free or at reduced rates to any place; fixing the amount and providing for the collection thereof; and prescribing penalties, be and the same is hereby repealed effective September 1, 1954.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
