ORDINANCE 0-4567

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE PETTY CASH FUND AND REMOVING THE REFERENCE TO THE EASTSIDE NARCOTICS TASK FORCE.

WHEREAS, as part of a legal review of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") by Code Publishing Company it was noted that KMC Section 5.69.010(2) provides for a petty cash fund contribution from the City of Kirkland ("City") to the Eastside Narcotics Task Force, which task force has now been disbanded.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Kirkland Municipal Code 5.69.010 is amended to read as follows:

The director of finance and administration is authorized to establish a petty cash fund not to exceed fifteen twenty-five thousand dollars, composed of two categories of cash, as follows:

(1) Petty Cash. Such amount as the director of finance and administration determines necessary for the making of minor authorized disbursements and the making of change., but not to exceed fifteen thousand dollars.; and

(2) Eastside Narcotics Task Force. Amount of cash contribution from city of Kirkland held by the Eastside Narcotics Task Force, but not to exceed ten thousand dollars.

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
