ORDINANCE NO. 687

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RE-ZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTAL CLASSIFICATION TO COMMERCIAL CLASSIFICATION.

Whereas a hearing was had on February 20, 1956, by the Kirkland City Council and the Kirkland City Planning Commission in joint session at which time a proposal was considered for rezoning from residental classification to commercial classification certain property on Market Street in the City of Kirkland and said hearing was held pursuent to previous action by the Kirkland Planning Commission and in accordance with proper notice thereof, now therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is re-zoned from residental classifications to commercial classification:

Lots 14 to 21, Block 216, Town of Kirkland Lots 9 to 16, Block 208, Town of Kirkland Lots 9 to 16, Block 207, Town of Kirkland Lots 9 to 14, Block 194, Town of Kirkland Lots 1 to 7, Block 7, Town of Kirkland, King County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and its publication according to law.
