

ORDINANCE NO. 701

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, DECLARING THAT THERE EXISTS A PUBLIC EMERGENCY OF THE CHARACTER ENUMERATED IN THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON, SECTION 35.33.080, WHICH SAID EMERGENCY COULD NOT REASONABLY HAVE BEEN FORESEEN AT THE TIME OF MAKING THE BUDGET FOR 1956, AND APPROPRIATING THE SUM OF THREE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$3,000.00) AND AUTHORIZING THE IMMEDIATE EXPENDITURE OF SAID SUM FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING, REPAIRING AND RESTORING OF THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND IN EXCESS OF THE ESTIMATED COST OF THE EXPENSE OF THE GENERAL GOVERNMENT WHICH INCLUDES THE MAINTENANCE, REPAIRING AND RESTORING OF THE STREETS AND PUBLIC WAYS IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

THAT WHEREAS, an emergency exists which affects the health and welfare of the population of the City of Kirkland in that the City streets and public ways cannot be properly maintained and protected without immediate expenditures for maintenance, repairing and restoring, and it is necessary that such work be done to adequately serve the needs of the citizens of Kirkland, and additional funds in the amount of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) are necessary to pay the expenses thereof for the balance of the fiscal year of 1956;

AND WHEREAS, the necessity of said expenditures could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of the preparation of the budget for the fiscal year of 1956, and the appropriation therefor by the City Council, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DOES HEREBY FIND that an emergency exists for the appropriation of the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) to be used for said uses and purposes, and there is hereby appropriated for the General Government of the City of Kirkland for the specified uses of maintaining, repairing and restoring the streets and public ways in the City of Kirkland, the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00). It is further ordained that the sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) be transferred from the Replacement-Reserve Fund of the Water-Sewer Department as a loan from said Replacement-Reserve Fund to be repaid to that Fund without interest during the fiscal year of 1957.

This Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and welfare of the residents and citizens of the City of Kirkland, and is hereby declared to be in full force and effect immediately.

Introduced the 3rd day of September, 1956, an emergency declared and this Ordinance passed and approved this 17th day of September, 1956.
