ORDINANCE NO. 702

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND INCREASING WATER SERVICE CHARGES BY AN ADDITIONAL TWENTY-FIVE CENTS ON EACH AND EVERY BASE RATE CHARGE INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS, TO BE EFFECTIVE NOVEMBER 1, 1956.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That effective November 1, 1956, each and every base rate charge by the City of Kirkland for water service inside and outside of the city limits shall be increased twenty-five cents per month.

Section 2. There shall be no changes on overage charges or amount of water allowed under any rate as now established.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.

Introduced the 1st day of October, 1956.
