ordinance no. 7-0 4

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON CREATING A FOUR-WAY ARTERIAL STOP AT THIRD STREET AND 18th AVENUE AND ARTERIAL STOPS AT 16th AVE. WEST ON 6th STREET WEST.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The intersection of 3rd Street and 18th Avenue in the City of Kirkland shall be, from the effective date of this ordinance, a four way arterial stop intersection.

Section 2. 16th Avenue West in the City of Kirkland shall be an arterial stop street for traffic travelling in both directions on 6th Street West, from the effective date of this ordinance, and traffic on 6th Street West shall yield the right-of-way to vehicles on 16th Avenue West at the intersection of the said streets.

Section 3. The Police Department and the Street Department in and for the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect, in the proper places, stop-signs and notices of the same at the points of intersections above referred to.

Section 4. Violations of this ordinance shall be prosecuted and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
