ORDINANCE NO. 706

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, PROHIBITING THE PARKING ON SECOND STREET FROM THIRD AVENUE TO CENTRAL WAY OF CARS, TRAILERS, TRUCKS, MOTOR VEHICLES AND WHEELED VEHICLES OF ANY KIND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is prohibited on Second Street in the City of Kirkland from Third Avenue to Central Way. This prohibition shall apply to cars, trailers, trucks, motor vehicles and wheeled vehicles of any kind.

Section 2. The Police Department and the Street Department in and for the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect in proper places signs giving notice of the no parking rule.

Section 3. Violations of this ordinance shall be prosecuted and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland. It is specifically provided that for a violation of this ordinance car or other vehicles of any kind may be impounded by or under the direction of the Police Department of the City of Kirkland and held pending payment of impounding, storage and penalty charges.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
