ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CARS, TRAILERS, TRUCKS, MOTOR VEHICLES AND WHEELED VEHICLES OF ANY KIND ON EITHER SIDE OF LAKE STREET SOUTH FROM SECOND AVENUE SOUTH TO THE CITY LIMITS, EXCEPT FOR 30-MINUTE LOADING AND UNLOADING ZONES IN FRONT OF BUSINESS PLACES TO BE DESIGNATED AND POSTED BY THE KIRKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking is prohibited on either side of Lake Street South in the City of Kirkland, King County, Washington, from Second Avenue South to the South City Limits. This prohibition shall apply to cars, trailers, trucks, motor vehicles and wheeled vehicles of any kind.

Section 2. Thirty-minute loading and unloading zones in front of business places are hereby authorized, and the Police Department and the Street Department in and for the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect in proper places signs giving notice of the no parking rule and designating loading and unloading zones.

Section 3. Violations of this ordinance shall be prosecuted and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland. It is specifically provided that for a violation of this ordinance car or other vehicles of any kind may be impounded by or under the direction of the Police Department of the City of Kirkland and held pending payment of impounding, storage and penalty charges.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
