AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 398 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND ESTABLISHING CLOSING HOURS AT ALL PLACES WHERE BEER IS SOLD TO BE 2 A.M. EACH DAY EXCEPT SATURDAY NIGHT SHALL BE 12 MIDNIGHT AND ESTABLISHING OPENING HOURS FOR SUCH PLACES TO BE 6 A.M.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 398 of the City of Kirkland which reads as follows: "No place where beer is sold, shall remain open later than one o'clock at night, and shall not open for the sale of beer before 5:30 o'clock in the morning" be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 2. That Section 7 of Ordinance No. 398 of the City of Kirkland shall read as follows: No place where beer is sold, shall remain open later than two o'clock A.M. at night each week day except Saturday, when closing shall be twelve midnight, and shall not open for the sale of beer before 6 A.M. in the morning.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
