ORDINANCE NO. 725

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR TWO HOUR PARKING LIMIT ON BOTH SIDES OF LAKE STREET SOUTH FROM SECOND AVENUE SOUTH TO FIFTH AVENUE SOUTH, PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF CARS, TRAILERS, TRUCKS, MOTOR VEHICLES AND WHEELED VEHICLES OF ANY KIND ON THE EAST SIDE OF LAKE STREET SOUTH FROM SECOND AVENUE SOUTH TO THE SOUTH CITY LIMITS BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 4:00 P.M. TO 6:00 P.M., AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 717.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Parking shall be limited to not over two hours on both sides of Lake Street South from Second Avenue South to Fifth Avenue South subject to the additional restriction that parking is prohibited on the east side of Lake Street South in the City of Kirkland, King County, Washington, from Second Avenue South to the South City Limits between the hours of 4:00 P.M. and 6:00 P.M.

Section 2. These prohibitions shall apply to cars, trailers, trucks, motor vehicles and wheeled vehicles of any kind.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 717 regulating parking on Lake Street South is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Violations of this ordinance shall be presented and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland. It is specifically provided that for a violation of this ordinance cars or other vehicles of any kind may be impounded by or under the direction of the Police Department of the City of Kirkland and held pending payment of impounding, storage and penalty charges.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publication according to law.
