AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, PRESCRIBING THAT IN LIEU OF PUBLICATION ALL ORDINANCES OF THE CITY MAY BE PRINTED AND POSTED IN AT LEAST THREE PUBLIC PLACES IN THE CITY; DESIGNATING THREE PUBLIC PLACES FOR POSTING; DEFINING OFFICIAL NEWS: PAPER AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES INCONSISTENT HEREWITH.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS: Section 1. In lieu of publication all Ordinances of the City of Kirkland may be printed and posted in at least three public places in the City.

Section 2. The three public places for posting all Ordinances passed by the Council of the City of Kirkland and for posting all other public documents or notices required by law to be posted shall be the following:

(1) The Bulletin Board in the City Hall.

(2) The Bulletin Board in the Kirkland Post Office. (3) The Bulletin Board in the Citizens Bank of Kirkland.

Section 3. All Notices and other matters requiring publication by State law shall be published for two successive weeks or as required by State law in the Official Newspapeer for said City which may be the East Side Journal or other newspaper published in the City to be designated annually by the City Council in the award after call for bids as for other contracts of the City of Kirkland.

Section 4. Ordinances 2, 76, and 77, and any other Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication according to law.
