

ORDINANCE NO. 754

AN ORDINANCE TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING LOTS 11, 12, AND 13, BLOCK 38, MAP OF KIRKLAND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FROM R-12.5 to C-1.

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission upon its own motion considered the rezoning of certain property hereinafter specifically described from R-12.5 to C-1 and subsequently, pursuant to proper notices, a hearing was had by the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland on January 15, 1959, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, and the City Council having considered the matter of rezoning on January 19, 1959; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from Residential, R-12.5, to C-1 classification:

Lots 11, 12 and 13, Block 38, Map of Kirkland, according to Plat recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 53 to 67 inclusive, Records of King County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.


