AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 223, SECTION 2 THEREOF, PROVIDING THAT IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON TO EXHIBIT IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ANY OBSCENE OR INDECENT BOO K, MAGAZINE, ENGRAVING, DRAWING OR PHOTOGRAPH, OR ANY BOOK, PAMPHLET, MAGAZINE, NEWSPAPER OR OTHER PAPER DEVOTED TO THE PUBLICATION, OR PRINCIPALLY MADE UP, OF CRIMINAL NEWS, POLICE REPORTS OR ACCOUNTS OF CRIMINAL DEEDS OR PICTURES OR STORIES OF DEEDS OF BLOODSHED, LUST OR CRIME.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 223, which reads as fol-"SECTION 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to exhibit, in any park in the Town of Kirkland, any obscene or indecent book, magazine, engraving, drawing or photograph, or any book, pamphlet, magazine, newspaper or other paper devoted to the publication, or principally made up, of criminal news, police reports or accounts of criminal deeds or pictures or stories of deeds of bloodshed, lust or crime," shall be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows: "SECTION 2? It shall be unlawful for any person to exhibit in the City of Kirkland any obscene or indecent book, magazine, engraving, drawing or photograph, or any book, pamphlet, magazine, newspaper or other paper devoted to the publication, or principally made up, of criminal news, police reports or accounts of criminal deeds or pictures or stories of deeds of bloodshed, lust or crime."

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 223 be and the same hereby is in all other respects confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
