ORDINANCE NO. 764

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING LOTS 16 AND 17, BLOCK 129, BURKE & FARRAR'S KIRKLAND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE, DIVISION NO. 27, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FROM R-12.5 TO R-2.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described from R-12.5 to R-2, and subsequently, pursuant to proper notices, a hearing was had by the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland on April 16, 1959, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, and the City Council having considered the matter on April 20, 1959, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R-12.5 to R-2:

Lots 16 and 17, Block 129, Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle, Division No. 27, King County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
